

"Be keen on / be keen to" : significado

To be keen on [doing something] ou *to be keen [to do something]* contém o sentido de estar com muita disposição ou entusiasmado para fazer algo ou simplesmente gostar de [fazer] algo, ser fã de algo.

Alguns exemplos:

Ex: Dave isn't very keen on going to the opera.

Ex: The children are keen on swimming this afternoon. Shall I take them?

Ex: Qatari families are keen to take care of orphans.
